The highest achievers manage **their** time very well. Good time management requires an important move in focus from activities to results: being busy isn't the same as being effective.

Spending your day doing overloaded activities often achieves less, because you're dividing your attention between so many different tasks. "Time management" refers to the way that you organize and plan how long you spend on specific activities.

It may seem strange to spend precious time to learning about time management, instead of using it to get on with your work, but the benefits are great:

- Increased opportunities for advancement.

Failing to manage your time effectively can have some very unwanted results:

- Missed deadlines.
- Inefficient work productivity.
- Poor work quality.
- Higher stress levels.
